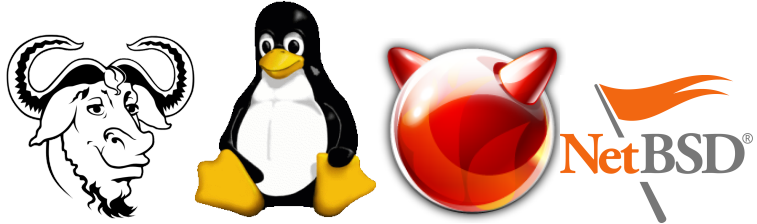


# Carnegie Mellon University Computer Club
